Standard Mandatory DoD Notice and Consent

You are accessing a U.S. Government (USG) Information System (IS) that is provided for USG-authorized use only. By using this IS (which includes any device attached to this IS), you consent to the following conditions:

DMDC's User Maintenance Portal (UMP), in conjunction with the Post-Issuance Portal (PIP), is designed to process Common Access Card (CAC) holder requests to update e-mail addresses, e-mail certificates, and add and update CAC applications. UMP was created to allow users the option of performing these updates from the convenience of their own desktop instead of requiring them to queue at a RAPIDS issuance location. In addition to increasing user convenience, the UMP relieves organizations of the administrative burdens currently associated with processing CAC holder post-issuance requests. Most importantly, the UMP accomplishes these goals without compromising the high level of security provided by current processes.

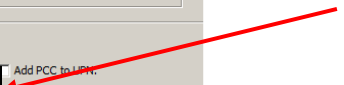

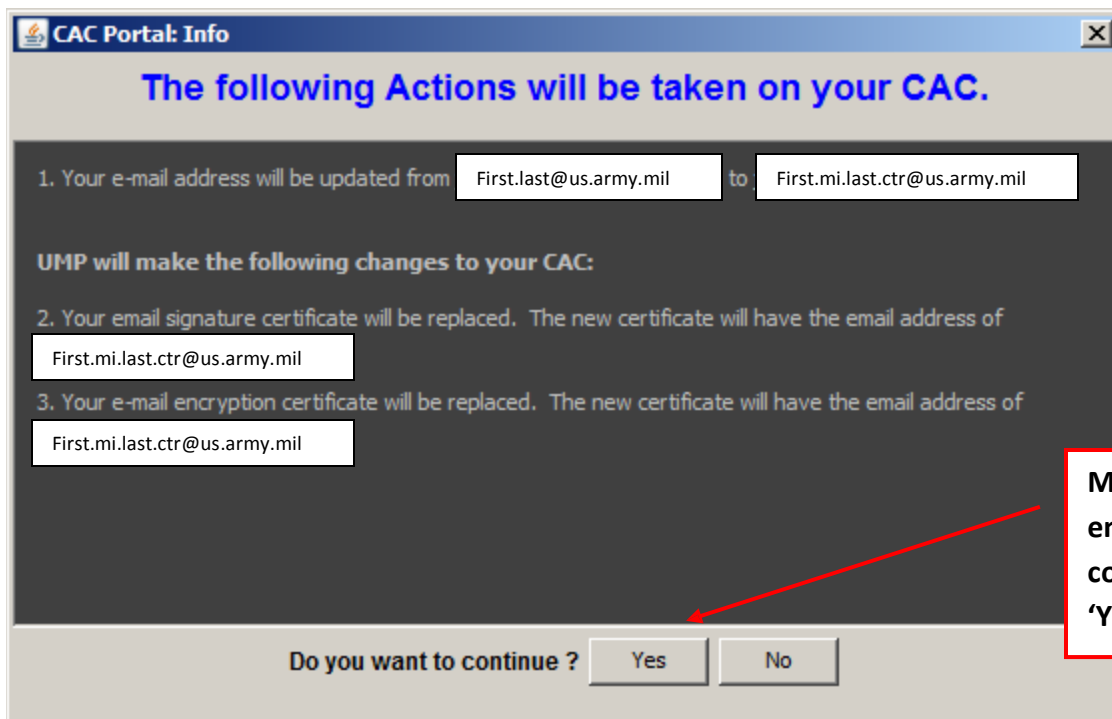
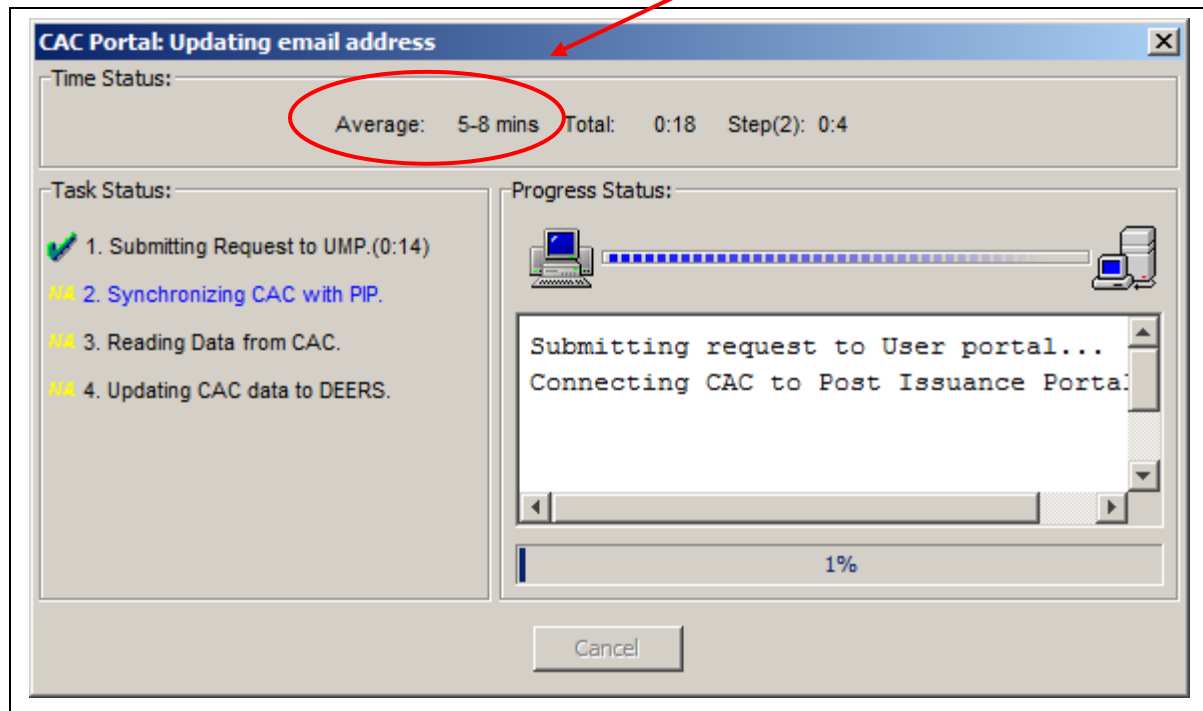
